• 1 Information on the collection of personal data

(3) When you contact us by e-mail or via a contact form, the data you provide (your e-mail address, your name and telephone number if applicable) will be stored by us in order to answer your questions. We delete the data arising in this connection after storage is no longer necessary or restrict processing if there are legal storage obligations.

• 2 Your rights

(1) You have the following rights in relation to the personal data concerning you:

• 3 Collection of personal data when visiting our website

- Browser

• 4 Further functions and offers of our website

(1) In addition to the purely informative use of our website, we offer various services which you can use if you are interested. For this purpose, you will generally have to provide additional personal data which we use to provide the respective service and to which the aforementioned data processing principles apply.

(2) In some cases we use external service providers to process your data. These have been carefully selected and commissioned by us, are bound by our instructions and are checked regularly.

(3) Furthermore, we may pass on your personal data to third parties if we offer campaigns, competitions, the conclusion of contracts or similar services together with partners. You will receive more detailed information on this when you provide your personal data or in the description of the offer below.

(4) If our service providers or partners are based in a country outside the European Economic Area (EEA), we will inform you of the consequences of this in the description of the offer.

• 5 Objection or revocation against the processing of your data

• **6 Integration of Google Maps**

• **7 Plugin WP Statistics**

Data protection regulations on the use and application of WP Statistics (with anonymization function) The data controller has integrated the WP Statistics (with anonymization function) component on this website. WP Statistics is a Web analysis service. Web analysis is the collection, collection and evaluation of data on the behavior of visitors to Internet pages. Among other things, a Web analytics service collects data about the Internet page from which a person affected came to an Internet page (referrer), which subpages of the Internet page were accessed or how often and for how long a subpage was viewed. A web analysis is mainly used to optimize an internet page and for cost-benefit analysis of internet advertising. The operating company of WP Statistics is Verona Labs, Mostafa Sufi, No 305, Flat 3, Aster tower building, Dubai. The purpose of the WP Statistics component is the analysis of visitor flows on our website. Verona Labs uses the data and information collected to evaluate the use of our website, to compile online reports for us that show the activities on our website, and to provide other services related to the use of our website. WP Statistics is open source code Verona Labs places a cookie on the information technology system of the person

concerned. What cookies are has already been explained above. By setting the cookie, Google is able to analyse the use of our website. Each time the data controller accesses one of the individual pages of this website, which is operated by the data controller and on which a Verona Labs component has been integrated, the Internet browser on the data subject's information technology system is automatically prompted by the respective Verona Labs component to transmit data to Verona Labs for the purpose of online analysis. As part of this technical process, Verona Labs obtains knowledge of personal data, such as the IP address of the data subject, which Verona Labs uses, among other things, to trace the origin of visitors and clicks. The cookie is used to store personal information such as the time and place of access, the location from which access was made and the frequency of visits to our website by the data subject. Each time our website is visited, this personal data, including the IP address of the Internet connection used by the person concerned, is transmitted to Verona Labs in Dubai. This personal data is stored by Verona Labs in Dubai. Verona Labs may pass on this personal data collected through the technical process to third parties. The person concerned can prevent cookies from being set by our website, as described above, at any time by changing the settings of the Internet browser used and thus permanently object to the setting of cookies. Such setting of the Internet browser used would also prevent Verona Labs from placing a cookie on the data subject's information technology system. In addition, a cookie already set by Verona Labs can be deleted at any time via the Internet browser or other software programs. • **9 Application procedure**
